	SECTION 3	COMPOSITION/INFORMATION ON INGREDIENTS The sealant is a semi solid article based on a blend of rubber and polybutene with inorganic fillers, plasticisers and flow modifiers. It is laminated to a foil, which is itself a laminate of polypropylene and alu minium foil, wound on a paper release liner. The product is not classified as hazardous.
