Cayman Rapid is a remarkable resin coated fibre glass pipe repair and maintenance system that will even cure and set underwater.

What is Cayman Rapid?

Cayman Rapid is water activated, needs no mixing, leaves no mess and sets rock hard in minutes Cayman Rapid is also chemically resistant and will withstand the attack of even the most aggressive of products.

Cayman Rapid can be used as a stand alone pipe repair system with the pressure OFF. It can also be used in conjunction with additional products as part of a system that can repair pipework under pressure or "LIVE" Cayman Rapid can also be used to rebuild and replace failing pipe walls to maintain the pipework integrity.

How does Cayman Rapid work?

On a system with the pressure turned off:

- 1). Clean the pipework of any rust, dirt or oil.
- **2).** Observe and comply with the safety instructions found within the Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS).
- 3). Soak the wrap in water for 30 seconds.
- **4).** Apply the wrap with a 50% overlap to the damaged area of the pipe, starting and finishing about 2ins either side of the damage. We recommend you use the complete roll, certainly ensuring you have a minimum of 9 layers of wrap.
- **5).** Apply the polycarbonate film over the repair making small punctures in the wrap to enable carbon dioxide created by the cure to escape.

6). Await 'cure' which will be dependent on temperature. Repressurise the pipe and check the integrity of the repair.
